Subject – Report of Pre-monsoon Sanitation Campaign

Sir

This is in reference to Letter no – EDN-MND-G6/2016-20155-785 from the office of The Additional Deputy Commissioner about 'Pre-monsoon Sanitation Campaign'. DAV CP School Mandi undertook pre monsoon sanitation drive on June 23rd 2016 with a spate of activities as in accordance with the direction of Deputy Director of Higher Education Mandi. Staff and students were actively involved in Cleanliness Drive. They walked from the school at 8:30 am armed with required brooms, garbage bags and gloves to clean up every nook and corner of selected areas.

Following locations were selected :-

1. Shani Dev temple (Khaliyar)
2. Jawahar park (Khaliyar)
3. Lower khaliyar
4. Slum area in Lower khaliyar
5. Gurudwara at Lower Khaliyar
6. Upper khaliyar
7. Bawari in Lower Khaliyar near Kendriya Vidyalaya
8. Main School Branch of DAV CPS Mandi
9. Lower Khaliyar Branch of DAV CPS Mandi
10. Upper Khaliyar Colony

Brooming was followed by scraping, scrubbing and washing. Students collected filth, rubbish, garbage and debris and stuffed in garbage bags. Overgrown grass, thorny bushes and unwanted plants were eradicated. Water tanks were emptied, cleaner was applied on the walls of tanks, rubbed with scrubs and washed. Water logged areas were filled with mud and stones. The drains and ditches were cleared of filth and silt & sprayed with DDT to prevent mosquitoes from breeding. Staff and

students ensured that every nook and corner of the selected locations was spic and span.

The whole drive was quite inspiring and motivating for the staff and students. This not only served the purpose of Pre- monsoon sanitation but also made the students aware of the dignity of labour. Students realized that cleanliness and good sanitation provide clean environment to lead a healthy and safe life. Approximately 1 quintal of waste was collected in garbage bags, loaded in the tempo sent by Municipal Committee and carried to be disposed off properly.
