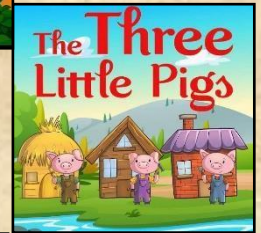

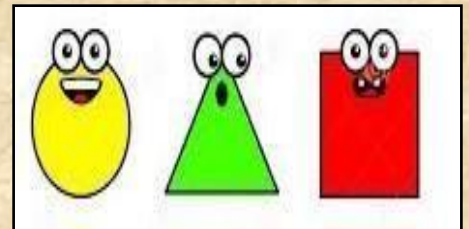
- ★ **Integrated activity Book** - Page No. 34 to 39

- ★ **Tracing of shapes** using bottle cap, pencil box, lunch box etc.



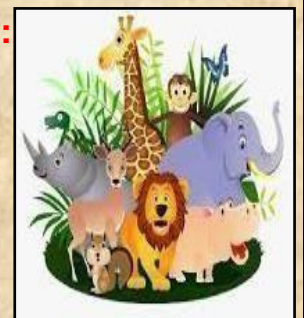
- ★ **Rote Counting** - 1 to 9 (oral)
