Holidays' Homework has been designed to fire your imagination, to make you explore, discover and reinvent. It's time to read new books in English or Hindi. The theme of Holiday's Homework is **ONCE A READER, ALWAYS A LEADER**

ENGLISH

1. Read a lot of magazines available for kids. Find good riddles, puzzles, poems, quotes or jokes. Take cut outs of the same and create a creative space for yourself to enjoy in your free time. Paste these in your English Grammar notebook.
2. Read story books related to animals. You will find lots of interesting pictures in them. Practice Picture Description taking those pictures in your rough notebook. (at least five)
3. Read the lessons of My English Reader Book. Find the meanings of the new words. Write them in the book only.
4. Learn the poems of My English Reader Book.
5. Improve your handwriting. Do 1 page of handwriting practice everyday in your rough notebook.

SCIENCE

1. Read chapters 1 to 5, underline the difficult words and write their meanings in the book itself.
2. Learn and revise chapters 1 and 2 for first periodic test.
3. Read newspapers, magazines etc. and collect any five articles related to plants and animals. Paste them on A4 size pastel sheets. (Maximum two articles on one sheet)

MATHEMATICS:

1. Read stories of mathematical concepts (addition and subtraction) and make your own number story.
2. Write two Mathematical quotations in the form of book mark.
3. Make a hanging model showing number name, expanded form and abacus.
4. Make a multiplication table wheel of assigned number (Roll no. 1 to 25 between 2 to 5:
Roll no. 26 to 50 between 6 to 10)
5. Rangometry: Make a beautiful rangoli using geometrical shapes.
6. Revise chapters done in the class.

NOTE: Q-1 and 5 TO BE DONE ON A-4 SHEETS.

SOCIAL SCIENCE

1) Read any English or Hindi historical stories of your choice like (Panchatantra, Chanda mama, Akbar and Birbal, Tenali Raman, Vikram Betaal, Amar Chitra Katha, Ashoka, Ramayana, Mahabharata etc) and write values you have learnt from them.

2) Make an ideal home model having compost pit, solar panels. (use materials of your choice like cardboard, bottles, colours, boxes, wood, foam etc.) (best out of waste) Students will be assessed for creativity, presentation and neatness.

3) * Revise the work done in notebook

* Read all the chapters of “We and our world” and underline the difficult words, write their meanings in book only.

4) Do practice of maps done in the class.

5) Revise and learn 29 states of India and locate, mark and colour 29 states of India on political map of India . (paste in notebook)
