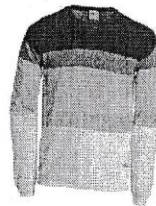

II "ARE YOU WEARING PLASTIC BOTTLES.....?"

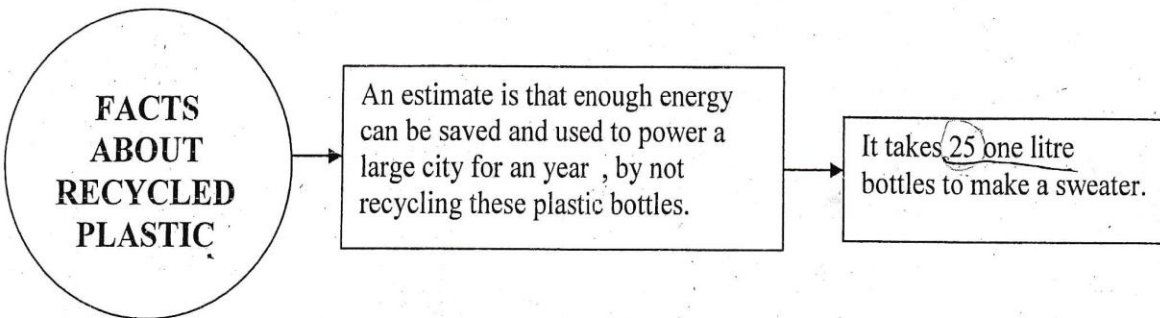
We all may be wearing plastic bottles
